

RESOLUTION  
Appointment of Freedom of Information Officers  
Public Act 96-0542  
R2010 CB 002

WHEREAS, Public Act 96-0542 becomes effective January 1, 2010, and this Act amends the Open Meetings Act, the Attorney General Act concerning a Public Access Counselor in the Office of Attorney General, and the Freedom of Information Act; and

WHEREAS, the County Board must designate one or more officials or employees to act as its Freedom of Information Officer or Officers; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Public Act 96-0542, the presiding officer of the Christian County Board does appoint, with the advice and consent of the County Board, such Officers.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Christian County Board that the County Board does consent to the following appointments as the Freedom of Information Officers for the designated areas of the County:

- \*Linda Curtin or position of County Clerk and/or his/her designee/s for all courthouse requests not related to the judicial system.
- \*Tom Finks or position or States Attorney and/or his/her designee/s for judicial related requests.
- \*Laura Cooper or position of Chief Probation Officer and/or his/her designee/s for probation related requests.
- \*Micki Ryan or position of 911 Coordinator for 911 related requests.
- \*Bob Kindermann or position of Sheriff and/or his/her designee/s for related requests.
- \*Gerry Grigsby or position of Health Administrator and/or her/his designee/s for all county health related requests.
- \*Cliff Frye or position of Highway Engineer/Supervisor and/or his/her designee/s for highway related requests.

Offices covered by each designated officer are as follows:

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County Clerk: All non-judicial offices in courthouse, Solid Waste, Animal Control, Zoning, County Board.

States Attorney: States Attorney, Circuit Clerk, Public Defender, Security.

Probation: Probation Office.

911 Coordinator: 911 Office/911 Board

Sheriff: Sheriff and Correctional Center.

Health Administrator: Health Department/Health Board/TB Board

Highway Engineer/Supervisor: Highway

All FOIA Officers must successfully complete the training curriculum before July 1, 2010 and annually thereafter. Newly elected county positions will automatically become FOIA Officers and must complete training within 30 days after assuming the position. The County Clerk of the County of Christian is hereby instructed to notify the Public Access Counselor in the Office of the Attorney General of such appointments.
